Dear Parent(s):

As the 'domestic church,' the family is the primary teacher of the faith. However, churches provide Catechism programs as additional support to the families, assisting in evangelizing all of our child(ren). Therefore, St. Anne's Catholic Parish has organized this year's Catechism Program to assist you in your role as the domestic church.

We, the Catechetical Team, are extremely honored that we are able to assist you in your role as the domestic church. We take our role seriously, and will do our best to pass on to your child(ren) the values, teachings, traditions, prayers, and symbols of the Catholic Church. This year's Catechism Program will cover the basics of our Catholic Church as presented in the St Joseph Baltimore Catechism. We will continue to work on the memorization of prayers. Those who wish to receive their sacraments will additionally be required to attend a two-week daily, after school, sacramental prep program taught by Fr. Tuckerman in the Spring. Classes will end in the church with Adoration and the Recitation of the Rosary.

Catechism is more than just learning, but living the faith God has given us through the Church. Therefore, it is critical that you assist your child(ren) at home by ensuring they are praying every night. This also provides your child(ren) with the best opportunity to memorize their prayers. Each week in class, we will introduce the lesson to the children. The activities completed (or maybe only started) in class will be sent home as a tool for the child(ren). We will also send activities home that are meant to be done as a family unit, which will be an additional source for the child(ren) to learn their prayers, and the Rosary. We expect your child(ren) to have the *Our Father* and *Hail Mary* memorized, and have a good grasp of the Apostle's Creed (age appropriate) by April. This is quite doable with nightly recitation/prayer.

We ask that at least one parent attend each class with their child(ren). If you have younger or older children, they are most welcome to attend, too. It is also important that the child(ren) is attending Mass, along with their family. This is a team effort, and it is important to have the entire team involved and present, as much as possible. Please do not hesitate to speak to Lara Lavoie if you have any questions or concerns.

We will meet weekly on Sundays during the time that school in Medical Lake is in session from 5:00-6:30pm beginning October 6th.

Thank you for being the domestic church! And, thank you for entrusting your children to us this year.
