Starters for this Holy Lenten Season ... Prayer, Fasting, Almsgiving.

Prayer—What is my daily plan of prayer? Does it begin with the Morning Offering and end with an Examination of Conscience? Does it need some tightening and refreshing? Can extra prayer time be added, such as visits to the Blessed Sacrament, extra daily Masses, etc.? Spiritual reading also falls under this category.

Fasting—Besides following the laws of abstinence and fasting and adding personal restrictions in extra food and entertainment, fasting can also be applied to the way we treat each other. Fasting can also be fasting from being critical, retaliating with anger and hurtful words, talking back, or speaking unkindly of others. Try replacing these acts with kind and positive words.

Almsgiving—This is the harder category to fulfill. This category can also be seen as “Acts of Love.” Acts of love should happen first at home and then extend outside of our homes by finding ways to do works of service, such as helping in a food pantry and helping with food drives. Almsgiving can also be seen in ways to give up treats and extra expenses and then share that money for those less fortunate.

“If anyone wishes to come after me, he must **deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me.** For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will save it.”

(Luke 9:22-25).
