It is time to bring our parking lot up to ADA code, fix the drainage issues, re-tar the cracks, and restripe.

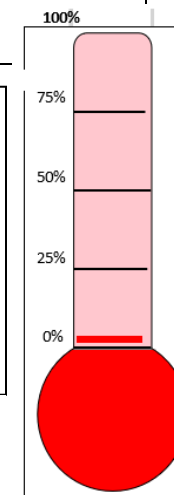
